The donor is unknown and the date of acquisition is unknown. They were removed from the Postcard Collection as they contained correspondence and appeared to have more value historically as a cohesive unit documenting one person. All the postcards are addressed to Miss Justine Bryson of Valley View, KY, and come from various places in Kentucky with different authors.

Scope and Content Note

The postcards in this collection are a mixture of lithographed and real photo postcards. They are about everyday topics, mostly asking Miss Bryson to come for a visit, asking permission to correspond with her, and saying "wish you were here."
